

Spanish 11B - Final exam outline (2019)

1 Listening

- Numbers and Time
- Match the question you hear to the answer
 - Basic questions (How are you, What are you doing, What do you like to eat, When do you arrive at school etc.)
- Match the place to the activity you hear e.g. You can read books and study = library
 - Useful to study: verbs and places
- Write true or false for statements you hear about a picture of a room
 - Useful to study: prepositions (on, under, behind...) and objects

2 Vocab - Translate into Spanish

- Study the 3 lists on Quizlet "Vocab for final exam" - There are around 750 words to study
- 50 words are on the exam, but the mark isn't out of 50 (maybe out of 40 or 44)

3 Reading

- Answer questions in English based on Spanish texts
- How to practice: Read any page in the textbook that has an article!

4 Write about yourself / any other topic

- Goal: 200 words
- Mark based on length, lack of repetition, variety (in vocab and grammar), and general clarity. It doesn't have to be perfect.
- How to practice: Write paragraphs without cheating with google translate; ask the teacher to correct the grammar in your practice paragraphs; study sentence starters

5 Grammar

- You will have to translate a dozen sentences into Spanish
- Your mark will be based on the number of mistakes you have.
- Useful to study:
 - conjugations in the present and past
 - phrases with 'gustar'
 - phrases for saying the time (hour, date, ... ago), weather
 - sentence starters
 - connecting words and prepositions (on, in, under, for, with...)
 - determiners (my, your, his, our, this...)

- Study the list of questions provided
